~Ancient Royal Capital Urasoe City~

Urasoe City is situated in the southern part of Okinawa Main Island, north of Naha City with the Naha Airport, and south of Ginowan City, where Futenma Air Station is located.

The eastern side of the city is hilly and slopes gently towards the west, leading to the coastline of the East China Sea. The city covers an area of approximately 19 square kilometers and has a population of roughly 115,000 people (as of the end of June in 2023).

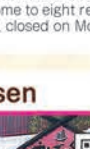

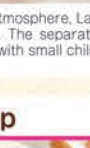

Tedako Festival



The festival features a variety of activities and festivals each year, but the biggest and most popular is the Tedako Matsuri. The Tedako Matsuri features a range of colorful activities, including taiko drum performances, concert, Harl boat races, and fireworks display; all of which create a festive atmosphere, like a refreshing breeze to "blow away the heat of summer".



Additionally, the festival features "The Kingdom of Urasee", as its main program. This is a celebration of the three most prominent kingdoms of Urasee. Under the rule of Kings Shunter, Eiso and Satto. The Ryukyu Kingdom employed 220 years of prosperity, displayed in this festival through a large-scale song and dance performance. With about citizens and visitors alike.

The Tedako Walk



At present, the event known nation-wide as the "Tedako Walk" attracts around 7,000 participants each year, making it the largest such event in the prefecture. The walk takes place in February, just before kamhi Zakura are in full bloom. The Tedako Walk is also widely known as one of the big three "signs of spring" in Urasee. Experiencing the natural beauty of the city while also getting to walk all over Urasee with people from all around the country is all just part of the fun!

Urasee Ori

Urasee Ori is a beautiful natural silk product made by extracting thread from silk cocoons and then coloring the threads with plant extract as a part of a plan to expand industrial growth in Urasee. Creating Ori by extracting silk from silkworms is a famous and characteristic part of Urasee culture. The beauty of Urasee Ori comes from the style with which it is made, the flexibility and weightlessness of its threads and the luster of its texture.

Teda-Kuwacha



In the silk industry, there was a substantial problem at least during the summer season when typhoons are prevalent and silkworms are creating a product that would most effectively use the mulberry leaves, we coordinated with the National Institute of Technology - Okinawa College and the Okinawa Prefectural Industrial Technology Center to create what would eventually become "Kuwacha" (Mulberry Tea), a product made from dried up mulberry leaves.

Additionally, you can purchase sweets made from mulberry and liqueur made of mulberry at various stalls.

From the 13th to the 15th century, Urasoe, the capital of Okinawa previous to Shuri, prospered as a cultural center and trade hub of the Ryukyuu kingdom. "Three Royal kings", Shunteen, Eiso and Satto who reigned during this time established the foundation of the Ryukyuu kingdom.

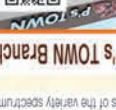
